A RESOLUTION OF THE BRAZORIA COUNTY REPUBLICAN PARTY OF TEXAS, ASKING BRAZORIA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT TO ADHERE TO THE FEDERAL HIPAA PRIVACY RULE AND PROTECT THE PRIVACY AND RIGHT OF SELF-DETERMINATION OF INDIVIDUAL BRAZORIA COUNTY CITIZENS WITH RESPECT TO COVID-19 IMMUNIZATION

WHEREAS the Federal HIPAA Privacy Rule prevents any health care provider from disclosing a citizen's protected health information (PHI) to any public or private entity without express authorization from the individual citizen:

WHEREAS the COVID-19 vaccine has been made readily available and easily accessible to anyone who chooses to receive it at no cost to the recipient;

WHEREAS citizens of Brazoria County possess the God-given, Constitutionally-protected right to make decisions regarding their own healthcare WITHOUT being harassed, targeted, pressured, or influenced; including whether or not to receive the COVID-19 vaccine: now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the Brazoria County Republican Party (BCRP):

- that the BCRP commends the Brazoria County Commissioners Court for making the COVID-19 vaccine readily available and easily accessible to those who choose to receive it across Brazoria County;
- 2. that the BCRP commends the Brazoria County Commissioners Court for not hiring any firm or entity for the purpose of tracking, revealing, or contacting those citizens in Brazoria County who have or have not received the COVID-19 vaccination:
- 3. that the BCRP commends the Brazoria County Commissioners Court for its practice of protecting the rights of Brazoria County citizens by supporting every individual's right to choose whether or not to receive any drug or vaccine WITHOUT coercion; and
